Lale features a puffy, rounded back inspired by the shape of a tulip, with a lace pattern on the sleeves reminiscent of tulip petals.

It is worked seamlessly from the top down.

EYLUL yarns Lale

[200g / 1140m / 53% wool, 43% linen]

col.Berry Pink approximately 146g / 761m

Pierrot Yarns Julika

[30g / 346m / 51% Mohair, 34% Nylon, 15% Merino]

col.03 Berry Berry approximately 60g / 692m

The two yarns are held together

NEEDLES

4.8mm / JP9 circular needle

4.2mm / JP7 circular needle

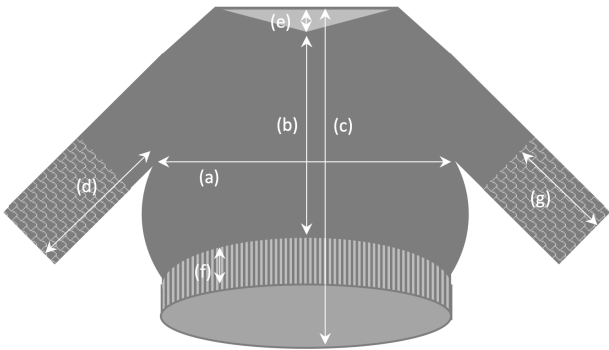
GAUGE

15 sts and 25 rows = 10cm
In Stockinette stitch with 4.8mm / JP9 needle

SEC. 1: NECK

Use **4.2mm / JP7** circular needle

R1: CO92 using Long Tail method, PMM for BOR,
Join to work in the round

R2: SMM, P2 for Right Sleeve, PM, P49 for Front, PM,
P2 for Left Sleeve, PM, P39 for Back

R3: SMM, K to MM

R4: SMM, P to MM

SEC. 2: YOKE

Change to **4.8mm / JP9** circular needle

Start **German Short Rows (V-neck Shaping)** and **Raglan Increases**

SR1(RS): SMM, M1L, K to M, M1R, SM, K1, M1L, K4, SSK, K1, Turn

SR2(WS): MDS, P to MM, SMM, P1, M1PR, P to 1 st bef M, M1PL, P1,
SM, M1PR, P to M, M1PL, SM, P1, M1PR, P4, P2tog, P1, Turn

SR3(RS): MDS, K to MM, SMM, M1L, K to M, M1R, SM, K1, M1L,
K to DS, KDS, K1, SSK, K1, Turn

SR4(WS): MDS, P to MM, SMM, P1, M1PR, P to 1 st bef M, M1PL, P1, SM, M1PR, P to M, M1PL, SM, P1, M1PR, P to DS, PDS, P1, P2tog, P1, Turn

SR5-10: [SR3-4] 3 times

SR11(RS): MDS, K to MM

> 12 sts for each Sleeve, 49 sts each for Front and Back

End German Short Rows and Continue **Raglan Increases**

R1: SMM, [M1L, K to M, M1R, SM, K1, M1L, K to 1 st bef M, M1R, K1], SM, repeat [-] (Knitting DS)

> 8 sts inc, 14 sts for each Sleeve, 51 sts each for Front and Back

R2: SMM, K to MM

R3-34: [R1-2] 16 times

> 46 sts for each Sleeve, 83 sts each for Front and Back

SEC. 3: BODY

Separate Sleeves and Body

R1: SMM, Place 46 sleeve stitches on a holder, CO8, RM, K to M, RM, Place 46 sleeve stitches on a holder, CO8, SM, K to MM

> 99 sts for Front, 83 sts for Back

R2: SMM, K to MM

Start **German Short Rows on Back**

SR1(RS): SMM, K to M, SM, K to 5 sts bef MM, Turn

SR2(WS): MDS, P to 5 sts bef M, Turn

SR3(RS): MDS, K to 7 sts bef DS, Turn

SR4(WS): MDS, P to 7 sts bef DS, Turn

SR5-10: [SR3-4] 3 times

SR11(RS): MDS, K to MM (Knitting DS)

End German Short Rows and **Increase on Back**

R1: SMM, K to MM (Knitting DS)

R2: SMM, K to M, SM, [K2, M1R] 20 times, K3, [M1L, K2] 20 times

> 40 sts inc, 123 sts for Back, 99 sts for Front

Start Body in **Stockinette stitch**

Work in Stockinette stitch until body measures 23cm from underarm

Start **German Short Rows before Hem**

SR1(RS): SMM, K43, Turn

SR2(WS): MDS, P to MM, SMM, P to M, SM, P43, Turn

SR3(RS): MDS, K to M, SM, K to MM, SMM, K to 7 sts bef DS, Turn

SR4(WS): MDS, P to MM, SMM, P to M, SM, P to 7 sts bef DS, Turn

SR5-12: [SR3-4] 4 times

SR13(RS): MDS, K to M, SM, K to MM

End German Short Rows

R1: SMM, K to MM (Knitting DS)

R2: SMM, K3, K2tog, [K8, K2tog] 9 times, K4, SM, K5, K2tog,
[K8, K2tog] 11 times, K6

> 22 sts dec, 89 sts for Front, 111 sts for Back, 200 sts in total

SEC. 4: HEM

Change to **4.2mm / JP7** circular needle

R1-19: SMM, [K2, P2], repeat [-] to MM

BO all stitches in pattern

SEC. 5: SLEEVES

Use **4.8mm / JP9** circular needle

R1: Begin at the center of underarm,
Pick up and knit 4 sts from underarm,
K46 from a holder, Pick up and knit 4 sts from underarm,
PMM for BOR

> 54 sts in total

R2-39: SMM, K to MM

R40: SMM, [K3, M1L], repeat [-] to MM

> 18 sts inc, 72 sts in total

Start @ [Chart](#)

R1-60: SMM, [Chart] 4 times

> Work from R1 of Chart to R60 of Chart

> In R15, 8 sts dec, 64 sts in total

> In R27, 8 sts dec, 56 sts in total

> In R42, 8 sts dec, 48 sts in total

> In R54, 8 sts dec, 40 sts in total

> In R60, 8 sts dec, 32 sts in total

End Chart

Change to **4.2mm / JP7** circular needle

R1: SMM, K to MM

R2: SMM, P to MM

R3-4: R1-2

BO all stitches knitwise
